### **DOCTORAL SEMINAR & PHD GRANTS**

The doctoral seminar is organised within the framework of the Odysseus Summer School. Only those who have registered for the Summer School by paying the applicable fees are eligible to participate.

The doctoral seminar offers to participants the opportunity to present their PhD project to a panel of experts composed of members of the Odysseus Network. Participants will receive feedback on the subject, structure and methodology of their thesis and advice to strengthen their research. The seminar is addressed mainly to PhD researchers in law, but applications from researchers in political science or international relations dealing with legal aspects are also welcome.


#### **OPPORTUNITIES FOR FINANCIAL SUPPORT:**

Four grants are available for PhD students to be funded by the Odysseus Network. The financial support provided will cover the tuition fees (excluding the deposit of € 350), travel expenses and accommodation costs. Daily subsistence and personal expenses are not included. **Funded participants will be selected on the basis of academic record and financial situation.** Applicants must be willing to provide organisational support to the coordination team during the entire duration of the summer school. This will not interfere with their full participation in the classes.

**The deadline for the application is May 15, 2026**



## HOW TO APPLY (before 15 May, 2026):

2. Complete carefully the [PhD catalogue](#) on the Odysseus website
3. Send, via email to [odysseus@ulb.be](mailto:odysseus@ulb.be) the following documents:
  - Cover page with name, title of PhD, year of progress of research and email address of supervisor;
  - CV with detailed academic background;
  - Academic record for each year if applicable;
  - A summary (maximum 1 page) of PhD subject explaining its originality and added value to the current knowledge;
  - An overview (1 page) of the structure of the PhD;
  - The proof of payment of the deposit of € 350;
  - Applicants for funding must also submit a letter of motivation outlining their need for financial support.

**Incomplete applications will be disregarded.**
